Job Responsibilities:

- Engage and motivate students to learn in a vibrant classroom environment
- Participate in morning devotions, faculty meetings, and in-service opportunities.
- Demonstrate a history of discipline and counsel students from a Biblical perspective.
- Ability to maintain a safe and studious classroom environment
- Demonstrate a commitment to Christian education.
- Clearly articulated philosophy of developmentally appropriate student spiritual cultivation.
- Clearly articulated philosophy of Biblical leadership and service.
- Understanding of and appreciation for discipleship and the developmental needs of students
- Maintain student records as defined by school administration.
- Coordinate with parents, and teachers to identify and rectify student's issues, if any surface.
- Support and guide students with class curriculum if and when additional support is necessary.
- Participate in morning devotions, faculty meetings, and in-service opportunities.
- Plan, organize and supervise field trips, class projects, games, and other activities to promote educational developments.
- Monitor and track student progress and issue grades in FACTS system each marking period.

- Prior teaching and classroom experience at the Middle School and Secondary levels is preferred

Physical Requirements:

- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds if necessary.
- Must be able to traverse school grounds and facilities and lead students to safety in the event of an emergency.
- Must be available to work evenings and weekends when necessary
