- Excellent organizational skills and attention to detail.
- The ability to design lessons that teach curriculum in an engaging manner, applying various teaching methods such as lectures, discussions, demonstrations, and individual and collaborative projects and research.

**Job Responsibilities:**

- Teach knowledge and skills in art, including drawing, painting, art history, theatre, visual arts, dance or music
- Demonstrate knowledge of art, music, theatre or film curriculum and the ability to implement it.
- Communicate with parents and school administration on pupil progress
- Demonstrate techniques in activities such as drawing and painting
- Instruct students in proper care and use of art tools and art equipment
- Organize art storage areas and control use of art materials, art equipment and art tools to prevent loss or abuse, and to minimize time required for distribution and collection
- Evaluate each student's performance and growth in knowledge and aesthetic understandings, and prepare progress reports
- Plan and present art displays and exhibitions designed to exhibit students' work for the school
- Participate in morning devotions, faculty meetings, and in-service opportunities.
- Monitor and track student progress and issue grades in FACTS system each marking period.
