Overview:

Seaside Christian Academy (SCA) is recognized by the Maryland State Department of Education as a PreK3 thru 12th grade Non-Public, church-exempt school. Seaside Christian Academy is also a member of the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI), the American Association of Christian Schools (AACS), and the Maryland Association of Christian Schools (MACS). Seaside Christian Academy exists to educate children spiritually, academically, socially, and physically, equipping them for every good work in Christ Jesus. (Luke 2:52)

Spiritual Qualities:

- Have received Jesus Christ as your personal Savior
- Believe in the Bible as God's Word and standard for faith and daily living
- Be a Christian role model in attitude, speech, and actions toward others

Job Responsibilities:

- Responsible for planning and implementing physical education activities, monitoring students, and evaluating student outcomes.
- Teach sports-related skills, movement patterns, games, and fitness activities.
- Responsible to record and maintain student information. He or she is responsible for communicating with all parties involved in the education of the student.
- Organize, maintain and set up equipment prior to and after class, if necessary.
- Provide an atmosphere and environment conducive to the: spiritual, intellectual, physical, social, and emotional development of students.
- Prepare and implement lessons plans, providing for appropriate learning experiences for each grade level of students.
- Establish and enforce rules of conduct; outside on the blacktop, under the pavilion, or on the athletic fields.
- Demonstrate the skills being taught and assist students in performing those skills.
- Demonstrate the ability to teach safety rules related to each activity.
- May team teach with another Physical Education Teacher, if needed.
- Research, and order physical education and recess equipment, if necessary.
- Demonstrate the ability to plan, organize, and coordinate field day; develop activities; set up for activities.
- Monitor and evaluate student skill levels and outcomes.
- Prepare interim progress reports and quarterly report cards.
- Prepare information sheets for participation in parent-teacher conferences, if necessary.
- Communicate and interact with students, parents, staff, and the community, when necessary.
- Attend morning devotions, faculty meetings, team meetings, and in-service opportunities.
- Monitor use and care of equipment, materials, and facilities.

- Prepare lesson plans and materials for substitute teachers; include class lists, and any special instructions related to students' special needs.
- Create emergency lesson plans as required.
- Knowledge of emergency plans for the school, such as lockdown procedures.
- Participate in fire drills, as required.

Job Qualifications:

- Desire to teach Physical education and ability to adapt to the student's developmental status.
- Skill in conveying information effectively to different ability levels and learning styles in various grades.
- The ability to apply various teaching methods regarding the fundamentals of team sports as well as individual athletics.
- Ability to use logic and reasoning to appropriately handle problems that arise.
- Strong supervisory and leadership skills to manage and control the class.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Excellent interpersonal skills with the proven ability to maintain professionalism and tact in high-stress situations.
- Excellent organizational skills and attention to detail.
- Prepare lesson plans and materials for substitute teachers; include class lists, and any special instructions related to students' special needs.
- Ability to remain flexible with changes in routine or plans.

Education and Experience:

- Knowledge and experience playing sports and participating in athletic programs, preferred.
- Bachelor's degree in education or related field preferred
- Prior teaching and or coaching experience is preferred.

Physical Requirements:

- Must be able to lift up to 50 pounds at times.
- Must be able to traverse school facilities and lead students to safety in the event of an emergency.
- Must be able to tolerate noise from students performing activities
- Must be able to handle exposure to weather conditions when teaching outside of the school building
- Must be able to tolerate seasonal temperature factors
- May be able to handle exposure to humidity, wind, and pollen when teaching outside.
- Must be able to perform on blacktop and cement surfaces outside and on grass athletic fields

A Condition of Employment:

- Applicant must pass a pre-employment criminal background check with finger printing.
